-----DISCLOSURE STATEMENT-----

I hereby acknowledge I accept the following terms and conditions:

1. No more than one chicken per six hundred square feet of lot.
2. Chickens must be kept in a suitable cage or chicken coop, designated for chickens only (recommended minimum 3 sq. ft. per chicken).
3. Chickens are solely for the benefit of the family raising them.
4. Coops must be located in the backyard and no closer than 50 feet to the nearest portion of any building occupied by or in any way used by human beings, other than the dwelling occupied by the keeper.
5. All cages or chicken coops where a chicken is kept shall be maintained by the keeper in such a condition of cleanliness as to prevent obnoxious or offensive odors. Any structure where chickens are kept shall be maintained in a clean and sanitary condition. The enclosed area should be constructed to keep the inside dry at all times.
6. Chickens cannot graze in the yard.
7. Every coop must have a watertight and fly-proof receptacle for manure. The receptacle should be sufficient and emptied often to prevent it from becoming a nuisance.
8. The keeper authorizes the city to at any time inspect any structure and issue any such order as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.
9. No roosters are allowed.
10. Any person who shall own, keep, or harbor chickens, shall within 15 days of acquiring the chickens acquire a license for the chickens and shall renew the license annually by January 1.
